Helen Adams Keller was an American author, political activist, and lecturer. She was the first deafblind person to earn a bachelor of arts degree.

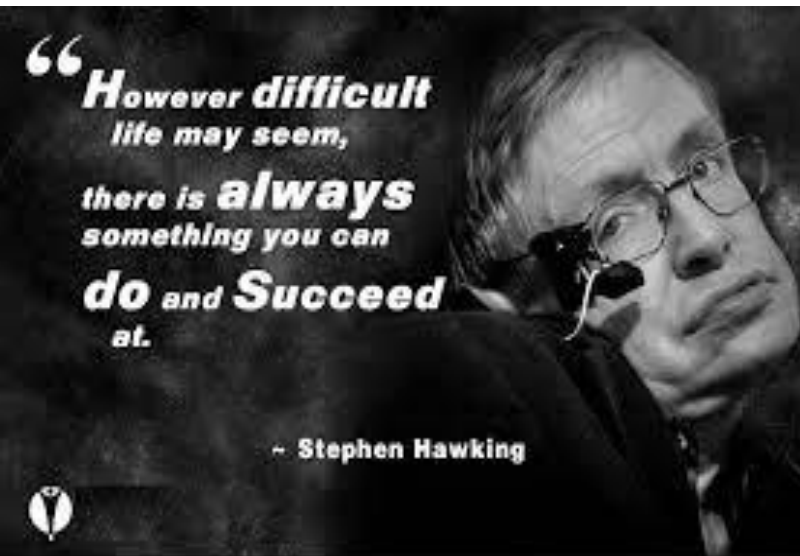
Some of the Successful PWD



Franklin D. Roosevelt was the only U.S. president to be elected four times. He led the United States through the Great Depression and World War II.

Franklin D. Roosevelt was the 32nd President of the United States. FDR was diagnosed with infantile paralysis, better known as polio, in 1921, at the age of 39. Although dealing with this crippling disease was difficult, yet he served an unprecedented four terms in office, AND he was also the first president with a significant physical disability.

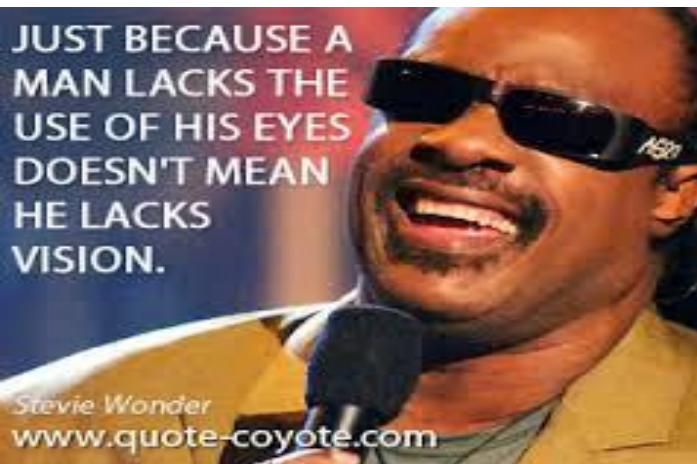
Some of the Successful PWD



Stephen Hawking is known for his work regarding black holes and for authoring several popular science books. He suffers from amyotrophic lateral sclerosis.

Hawking has a [motor neuron disease](#) related to [amyotrophic lateral sclerosis](#) (ALS), a condition that has progressed over the years. He is almost entirely paralysed and communicates through a [speech generating device](#).

Some of the Successful PWD



Stevie Wonder is an American musician and a former child prodigy who became one of the most creative musical figures of the late 20th century. His hit songs include "Living in the City," "Boogie on a Reggae Woman" and "Isn't She Lovely."

He was born six weeks premature, which, along with the oxygen-rich atmosphere in the hospital incubator, resulted in [retinopathy of prematurity](#) (ROP), a condition in which the growth of the eyes is aborted and causes the [retinas](#) to detach; so he became blind. [\[3\]\[7\]](#)

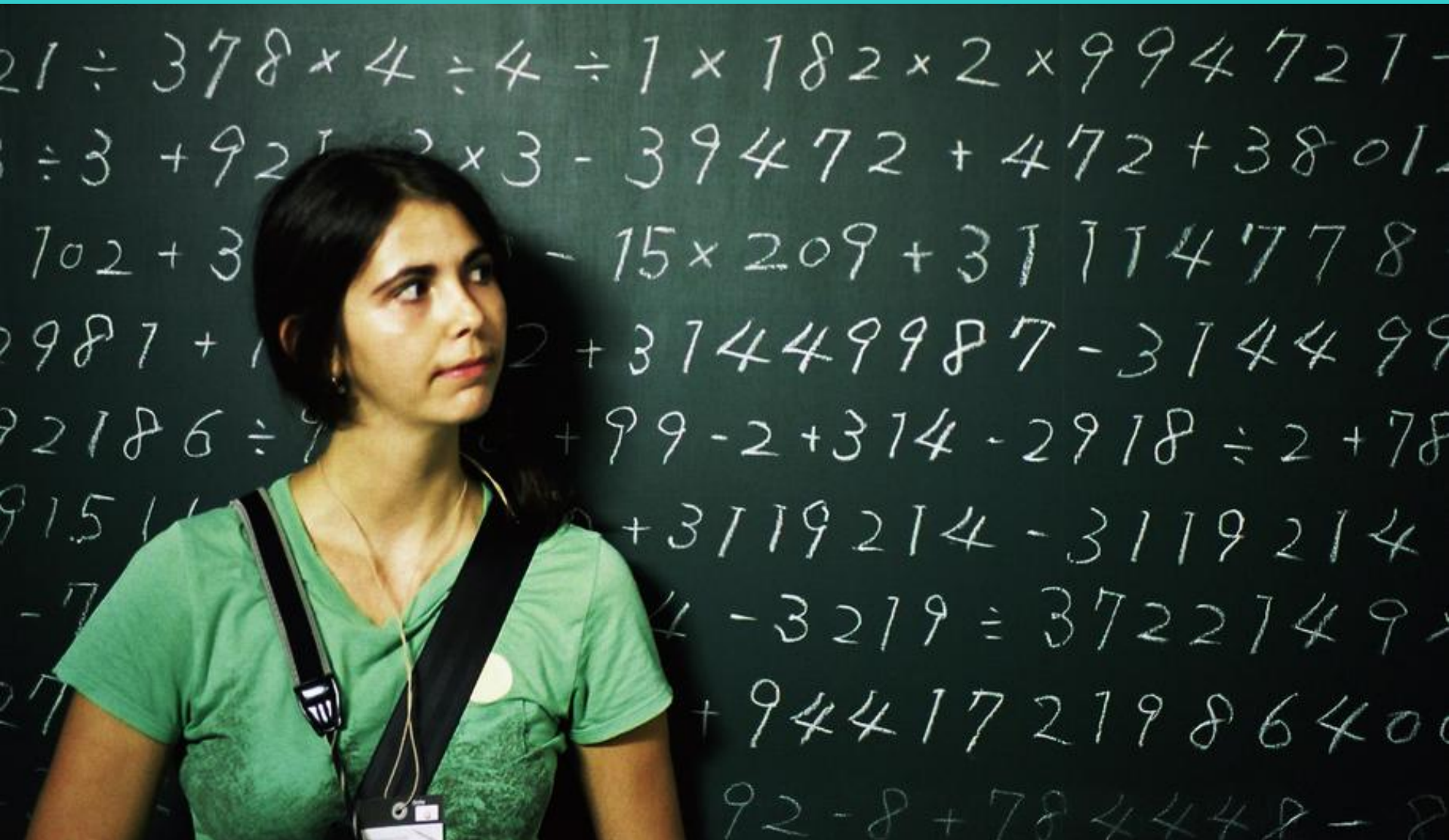
