# **Global Disability POA**

- WHO endorsed the Global disability POA in line with CRPWDs during the 67<sup>th</sup> WHA 2014
- Three objectives
  - 1. To address barriers and improve access to health care services and programmes
  - 2. To strengthen and extend habilitation and rehabilitation services, including community based rehabilitation and assistive technology
  - 3. To support the collection of appropriate and internationally comparable data on disability and promote multi-disciplinary research on disability

# **EARLY DETECTION**

#### **DURING PREGNANCY**

- Identify high risk cases
- Referral of high risk cases e.g. prolonged labour, fetal distress
- Postnatal visit to mother and child – early identification of problems

#### **CHILD**

- Physical examination
- Anthropometry
- Developmental Assessment
  - Gross motor
  - Fine motor
  - Hearing
  - Psychological and speech

# **EARLY INTERVENTION**

### THE CHILD

- Medical Intervention
- Therapy :- Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech
- Individual Care Plan: Care plans based on capabilities of individual child with focus on improving function and towards independence.

### THE FAMILY

- Family Education including siblings to enable understanding and skill development to assist child with special needs
- Family support groups

#### THE PARENTS

- Parent Education to improve knowledge and skill to help child
- Counseling individual and group counseling

#### THE COMMUNITY

- Interagency networking to improve results – making environment more friendly.
- Providing assistance to Community Based Rehabilitation Centers

- Training for caregiver in institutions








### Distraction Test (6 - 24 months)

A study of distraction test and TOAE in detection of hearing impairment in early childhood.(compared to ABR)(in 127 ears) Distraction test sensitivity 88.9%, specificity 93.5% TOAE:sensitivity 91% and specificity 88% (Asha Gupta et al)




